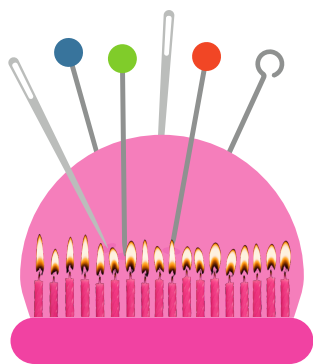

## ZOOM ANNOUNCEMENT!

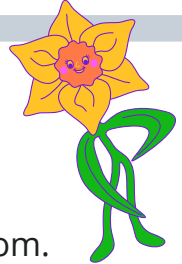

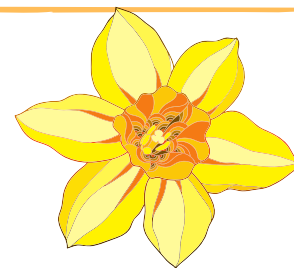

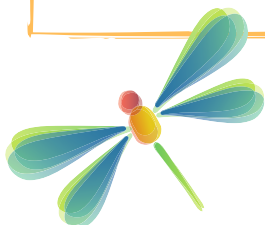

# Block of the Month



## APRIL – NINE PATCH

**The block is the simple and traditional nine patch. It will finish at 9 1/2".** This will use 9- 3 1/2" squares. Let's break out those bright spring colors! We will use darker colors in the corners and middle, lighter colors for the other four squares. Let's leave out the dark colors like Black, Navy, Dk Brown, etc this time. Think Spring! **DRAWING: Raffle drawing for those who bring in blocks. One entry per 2 block set. So the more block sets turned in, the more chances to win! The raffle winner gets all the blocks. 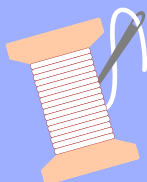
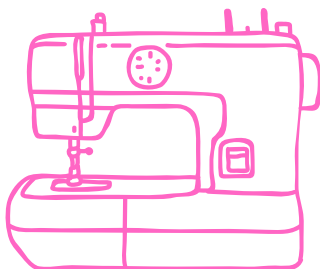

# MEETING NOTES



8 March 2022  
MHQG  
Member's Meeting

- Marie started the meeting at 7:00pm. Marie reminded us masks, worn appropriately, are required in the meeting. She asked that phones be turned to airplane mode to allow for more bandwidth for our Zoom speaker.
- Dottie introduced the Zoom Speaker: Lyric Kinard (on the East Coast). The name of Lyric's talk is "Taming of the Hues." In art there is: texture, shape, color, line and value. She is going to focus on color and a little value. Color is about relationships. Color is playful. Hue: color name. She recommended a 12 step color wheel blank that you can fill in with the primary, secondary, triads & neutrals. (Pink = red + white).  
Monochrome= one color. Analogous= friends w/color next to it. Triadic= equilateral triangle of colors. Complementary= exact opposite. Split Complementary= 1 color opposite and 2 that are close but split apart. Polychrome= every color plays together and doesn't require equal access/balance. Warm= Yellow/orange/red. Cool= blue/greens/purple. Only need a tiny bit of warm to balance cool. Value= how much light & dark. High Value= a lot of light. Value contrast to add pop. Visually we are used to light at the top and dark at the bottom. Value creates depth and dimension. Fill in a blank color wheel with your stash inventory- by color and value. Yellow= is a diva- it's a high value that doesn't go low. Low Value appears to recede. Latimer Quilt & Textile Center (museum) in Tillamook currently has a exhibit of Lynn Czaban's work. Look at the website for open days/hours. Tonite only: shop at Lyric's web stop for 25% off- enter HOOD. This also includes classes. She also mentioned the Global Quilt Connection (March 19 & 20th)- it's a zoom event- when you buy a ticket you can access the speakers video's for 24 hours. Thank you, Lyric!
- Break: Community Outreach quilt kits, T-shirts, Free Table, Fabric Find Table (donation), RedWagon for Human Solution donations, Opportunity Quilt (quilt show) blocks, BOM, Vote for Quilt Show Name, Sign ups for classes & National Quilt Day-lots to do!
- Stephanie & Suzi: They are stepping down as Retreat Coordinators. The next retreat will be in-person. Are you ready to be the next retreat coordinator? There is a place reserved for October. If no one steps up there will be no retreat. If you are interested contact Marie. Stephanie, Suzi and Tomme are willing to consult but you can make it your own. There are still openings for the Columbia River Retreat (March 17-20) contact Tomme if you are interested.
- Susan A-S: National Quilt Day is March 19, 2022, from 10am-3pm. We will be having the event in the big room at MountainView Church (where we meet). There is a sign up so we know how many tables to set up for sewing. There will be demonstrations, door prizes, adopt an orphan block, show off your antique machine, and more!
- Chunky Brick Quilts: Barbara Pelton won the gift certificate.
- Delleen with Community Outreach: last month we passed out 80 quilts. Still looking for domestic quilters- if you have a walking foot you can be a domestic quilter. She showed how to use a strip of binding to domestic quilt. There will be orphan blocks at the March 19th event- come and put some blocks together as friends to make a quilt. Also bring your vintage machines to show off. Delleen also showed us a 2 yard piece of labels- 504 labels- it won't get us through the year.
- Lori Oathes & BOM: Mary Nelson wins the blocks. The Spring Fling challenge: Lori is handing out 22" or 44" strips of fabric and building a block or quilt using the strip. The rules will be on the Website. Please bring your Spring Fling BOM to the June meeting.
- Shirley Workman: Quilt Show= Please pick up a block or 2 for the Opportunity Quilt. It is a paper pieced block. Return it to the April meeting. There will be blocks at the National Quilt day event too. The winning name: Quilts of the East Wind. The winner is: Martha Hurley (a gift card to MQL).

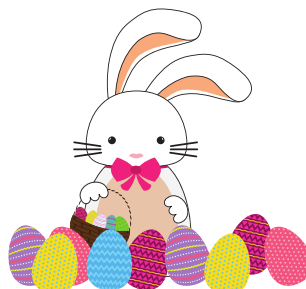

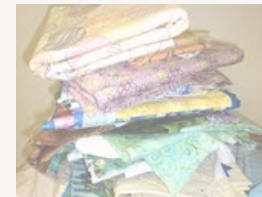
