We are off to a good start.

At our next meeting, we will be deciding the location and what we want to include in our show. Of course, we will have the display of quilts, an Opportunity Quilt, and the Boutique. Other events could be Vendors- any suggestions from you are requested; Mini-quilt Silent Auction; Speaker- again suggestion welcome; A Make and Take project; and any thing you have seen at other shows.

There is a need to get started on the Opportunity Quilt soon. So, if you are interested in working on it or have any ideas, please let us know.

Five inch blocks are always at hand after I've cleaned up a donated scrap pile. It seems like an easy way to cut and organize those extra pieces from others' projects.

Here's a quick idea to use some of those squares, and make a great looking quilt that puts your heart into the project!!

For a donation quilt that measures about 40x60



(8 half-sq. triangles)


Someone will feel all the **Quilty Love** that you put into it!





Simple straight line quilting with a walking foot makes a quick finish.
