Thank you to everyone who brought in a block last month as a special project for the Veterans bereavement quilt block drive. We got a call about an **urgent** need for bereavement quilts for the Veteran's Hospital in Portland. Our amazing guild members answered the call to help out with this need and turned in 11 blocks. It would be great to exceed that number this month.

For the January meeting, the BOM will again be a patriotic 12.5" unfinished block. The block can be any design, but we have a fairly easy free pattern at the link below. NOTE: We will have a raffle drawing for those who bring in blocks, and the prize will be a quilty surprise, because the blocks will be used for veterans quilts. The quilts made from the blocks will go to the American Legion Auxiliary who will deliver them to the Portland VA Hospital to be given to family members of veterans for comfort.


So far 3 beautiful quilts have been completed for this project by Delleen Kompkoff, Jere Barett & Debbie Stoffer! WAY TO GO!

Quilting Bingo! x 2


