

MT HOOD QUILT GUILD BOARD MINUTES

November 5, 2019

Donna Taylor started the meeting off at 7:00 p.m. with Susan Ainsworth Smith's idea of a March 21st "Stash Buster." Several members thought it is a good idea to sell extra fabric or notions that are duplicates or are no longer needed. Delleen Kompkoff mentioned that her and Susan thought an on-going activity at the same time would be a great idea. Lori suggested a practice session. Activities such as 'Days for Girls' or other activities might be good. It was said to let Susan (who was not in attendance) to go ahead with planning this. Laura Rom will go ahead and pay the next quarter of rent fees to the church including the \$90 for March 21st.
