Block of the Month

MARCH - QUARTER INCHER- AKA FOUR PATCH

The block for March is the easiest and quickest one yet! Only 3 short seams. Here is another chance to use up your smaller scraps. It is a four patch, but I named it the "Quarter Incher" here because it is a good way to check to see if your quarter inch is indeed a quarter of an inch. This block is fun to make because it goes very fast. The unfinished block is 4 1/2". DRAWING: Raffle drawing for those who bring in blocks. One entry per 4 block set. 

Dottie introduced Marie Anderson as our speaker: Leather and Leather quilting. Marie has been leather quilting for about 3-4 years. Don't quilt on tooling leather (to thick). Garment grade leathercan quilt on. Some leathers work for reverse applique Categorized by oz. The higher the oz the thicker the leather. The thicker the leather- can't quilt it. Tandy Leather, Cathy Wiggins, some places on line are all places to buy leather.

She does a class on making a leather journal cover. Class #2 is making a bag. She teaches classes where ever the need/desire. No classes are scheduled right now because of the pandemic. She will be scheduling classes soon. She has some leather kits for door prizes. She has scrap leather for practicing. Use a leather needle. Everything else is regular supplies (thread, rotary cutter etc).


