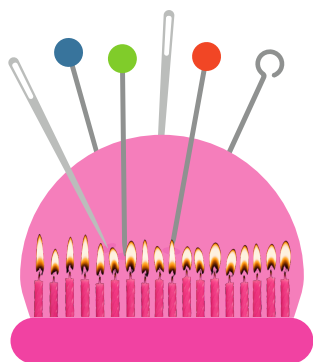

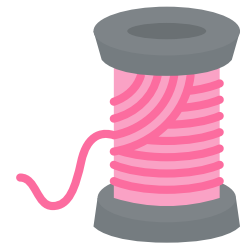

# Block of the Month



## MAY- NINE PATCH

We are carrying over the April block since many people couldn't make it last month due to bad weather. **The block is the simple and traditional nine patch. It will finish at 9 1/2".** This uses 9- 3 1/2" squares. Let's break out those bright spring colors! We will use the darker of the two colors in the corners and middle, lighter colors for the other four squares. This time we are leaving out the dark colors like Black, Navy, Dk Brown, etc.. Think Spring! **DRAWING: Raffle drawing for those who bring in blocks. One entry per 2 block set. So the more block sets turned in, the more chances to win! The raffle winner gets all the blocks. If you just want to make blocks to turn in, entering the raffle is optional.** There are many how-to websites for this block.

**Join in the fun! Tap your creativity!** How will you take a spunky but challenging, fabric and make it into something artistic or useful?

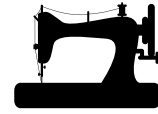

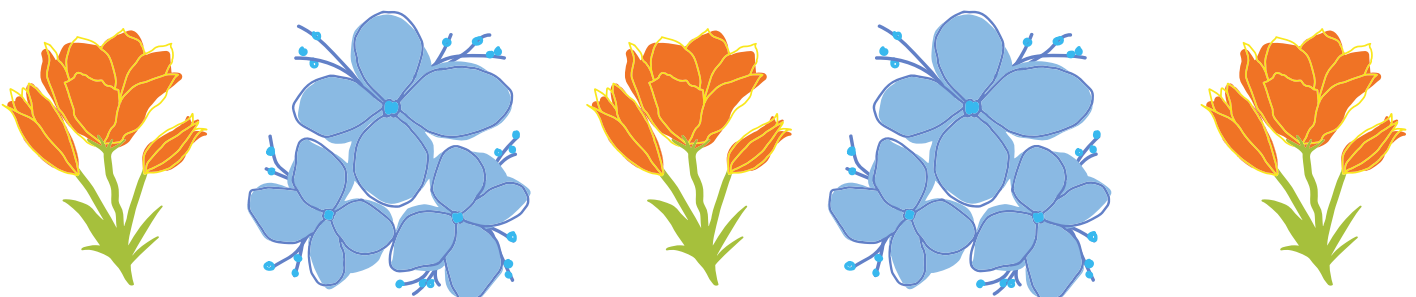
Sharon Jones won the zoom drawing.

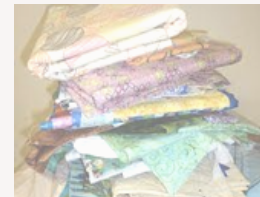
