Stitching Comfort Community Outreach

During the July meeting, we had 10 quilt tops and 17 finished quilts dropped off. It always inspires me to keep sewing, when I see how many other members are committed to stitching for the community. I'm wondering - where do some of you get your quilting inspiration? Now that more people are meeting in person, it is easy to get inspired from what others are making.

This week I found inspiration from biscuits and bindings. Those small pieces of binding leftovers have become a challenge for me to use in something other than string quilts.

I found something different (but basic) on a link from the guild website. Boxed Squares –

MaryQuilts.com This pattern was a great suggestion to use up 2.5"x 6.5" pieces, as well as a stack of 2.5" squares that was recently donated. I'm going scrappy, becausegot scraps? But I can see how this would help use up the remaining jelly roll pieces from another project. I'm making mine from kid-friendly pieces, with 6 blocks in a row and 2.5" side borders. 10 rows brings it up to 40"x60" - just right for our charities. You may find this an easy way to cope with your binding scraps as well.

The biscuits inspiration came from the take-out container after eating breakfast at Biscuits Cafe with the grandkids. Those boxes are too good to throw away after you eat all that food! Now they hold all my boxed squares blocks. This will become an ongoing project that is easy to organize. You may want to try it with your own take-out container!

In case you have quilt donations, and can't make it to a meeting we have a couple other ways to connect with Stitching Comfort. My Quilting Loft will accept guild donations, and now that Open Sew is meeting, you can also drop them off at the Saturday meeting. Thanks for all the support!
