Mt Hood Quilt Guild Meeting Minutes

11 May 2021 Membership Meeting

Becky started the Zoom meeting at 7:02pm. This whole meeting will be recorded (our speakers are our community donation organizations). This is the last meeting that will be recorded. We are not able to record speakers and the rest of the meeting information is in the newsletter and on the website.

Tonight we will hear from Ronald McDonald House (Ann Marie Rears is our liaison), Mt Hood Medical Center- Passages (Becky Caputo is our liaison), Human Solutions (Susan Ainsworth-Smith is our liaison), and Boxes of Love (Suzi Grunau is our liaison). We'll also talk about our current special project (Christmas stockings for foster kids).

From 2015-2020 MHQG has distributed 1494 charity quilts. This year (2021) we have already distributed 223 guilts.

The next Quilt Exchange is tomorrow! May 12th from 4-5:30pm at Mt. View Church Portico. Let Delleen or Susan know if there are any special things you need for Charity quilts. You can also pick up Blue Bags for the Bottle Drop fundraiser. You can also get Blue Bags at My Quilting Loft or Susan Ainsworth-Smith's driveway. There will also be Christmas Stocking kits at the Quilt Exchange. Remember- for Charity Quilts there are lots of free patterns on our website.

BreakOut Room #1: How many quilts are in your line of sight? The winner was Denise Foote.

Ronald McDonald House (video): Their mission is a free place to stay for families of children who are critically ill or injured. There are 4 houses in Oregon- 2 in the Portland Metro area (East and South Waterfront). The other 2 are in Bend and Springfield. They have quilts as part of their Welcome Bags for families. They also provide family programing, music therapy, pet therapy, craft nights and parties for the families. During the pandemic they have still been able to provide many of their services.

Mt. Hood Medical Center- Tom Vice/Chaplain. The Passage Quilts are given to patients (and then taken home by their family members) who are dying. The giving of the quilt is the start of the grieving process for the families, a transitional object. This past weekend 5 quilts were needed. The nurses are grateful to be able to give the quilts as it moves them briefly from their task role. 10-15 Passage Quilts are used each month. They need 40inch x 60inch quilts. They can use veteran quilts, and back/white quilts work good for men.

Rita McRoberts talked about the Christmas Stocking project for Restore Hope. 600 Christmas stockings will be made for kids in foster care in the greater Gresham area. The kits will be at the Quilt Exchange. There are materials for 12 stockings in each kit. The stockings will need to be done by June/July.

Human Solutions: Brielle Jones. The mission is to work with individuals and families who are homeless or in poverty. They have a Shelter, Women's Shelter, and a new Shelter at the Chestnut Tree Inn. They also have family advocates and career coaches. The quilts go to the Shelters and then the kids/adults take them to their permanent homes. The quilts are a favorite for comfort and care. Twin size is best but all sizes are welcome.

BreakOut Room 2: Do you Charity quilt? What's your favorite pattern/size? What are you looking forward to at the Summer Sale?

If you are bringing donations for the Summer Sale please let Delleen or Susan know so the items can be stored correctly. Boxes of Love: Suzi Grunau. Lindsay Wunn, a pedi nurse, started Boxes of Love in 2014. The mission is to give babies and kids leaving the hospital and going into foster care everything they need for their foster home- clothes, toys, formula/bottles and a quilt. For the MHQG Fall Virtual Retreat the charity project will be making a quilt for Boxes of Love. The sizes are 36x36 to 42x42. There is more information of the Boxes of Love website.

Fall Virtual Retreat: September 30-October 3, 2021. \$40. It will be virtual/zoom. Registration is open. You can mail your \$40 to the Guild PO Box or use Pay Pal (Pay Pal does charge a small fee). Registration is on the website. It will be limited to 40 people. Summer Sale: Thursday, July 29th, 9am-3pm in the Mountain View Church Parking Lot. CDC/OHA guidelines will be followed. There will be a wool sale (June's highlighted speaker, Linda Shaull, will be talking about wool applique), Stash Shuffle, Silent Auction (quilts), Raffle (antique sewing machine), and everything quilting you can imagine. Stash Shuffle spot is \$25- you set up your own "parking space" with your items, set your own prices, manage your own money, etc. If you are buying a spot for the Stash Shuffle that must be done by July 13th.- so we can allocate spots. You can also donate to the Guild sale tables (which will be pay what you can/think it's worth). You will also be able to

renew your membership!

- 1- We are holding an in-person meeting in the park in July. We will have a table set up to collect renewals via cash and checks at the meeting.
- 2- We will also have a table at the Summer Sale on July 29th. Again, cash and checks will be collected.
- 3- You can use the information from below to follow the same protocol as last year:

Mail in a check-

Checks would be preferable to the guild as we don't have to pay any processing fees. To pay by check you would go to our website and click on the About page from the menu. At the bottom there is a form that you can download, print, fill out and mail with a check to the post office box address on the form. The address is PO box 2376 Gresham Oregon 97030. P.S. if you don't have a printer just send in a note with your check & it'll be just fine.

Online with your PayPal account-

You need to have a PayPal account or set up a PayPal account at this time to use this method. (We are looking into setting up a Venmo type payment as well...will keep you posted) For this method, go to the Menu on the website that says 'Membership Renewal and New'. Click that and choose the appropriate type of form individual or business and hit add to cart. Fill out the form and hit add to cart again and then you can go to the cart which is in a little black box and check out with PayPal.
