OCTOBER 2022 BLOCK OF THE MONTH - FALL LEAVES



It's official, it is Fall. This month's pattern was inspired by all the new leaves in the yard. This is again an easy pattern with fairly large pieces that goes together quickly. This one makes really nice table runners or table toppers.

BOM DRAWING: One block = 1 ticket for the drawing. The winner of this month's drawing will also get a little extra something to go with your leaves.

What is the Block Of the Month or "BOM"?

Each month the Guild has a Block Of the Month challenge where a specific free pattern is designated for interested guild members to make. The block(s) are then made and brought to the meeting to turn in for a drawing. The blocks are displayed to inspire all members. One ticket is given for each block turned in.

The blocks are then raffled off and the winner gets all the blocks!

Each block has at least one specific skill to practice or learn to keep our skills sharp. This month we see a different kind of "stitch-and-flip" method to make the stem. I bet you will work this technique into other projects! The blocks are chosen to include all skill levels. So whether you are learning something new, or just want to be creative, give it a try!

You may just win the blocks !

Hint: Try putting 4 blocks together with stems pointing toward the middle to create a secondary design.




Stitching Comfort Community Outreach

SIMPLE GIFTS




Cutting Instructions: -Fabric Pieces 1-5: Cut 5 - 6" x WOF (width of fabric) strips


- -Border Pieces 6-9: Cut 4 - 6" x WOF strips.
- -Batting: One 40 x 60 batt

-Binding: Cut 5—2 1/2" × WOF strips and sew together for binding.

Finished quilt size: Approx. 38.5" x 51"

Assembly: Sew 6" strips together as shown in Steps 1-3 (including side borders).





Step 5: Sandwich quilt top, batting and backing.

Step 6: Quilt and bind.

Speaker was Nancy Goldsworthy. She spoke about sparkly threads, all things to know about thread and needles. All threads don't sew the same. As for needles, if the thread doesn't slide through the eye, it doesn't sew. If you have issues with the way the thread comes off the spool, use a thread stand. The class for Nancy's sparkly threads, at \$30.00 per person, is completely filled and there is a waiting list.



Quilt Intake Information

Quilt intake for our show will be happening at the October 6th general meeting from 6:00-7:00 pm as well as on October 11th at 6:00 pm for those that can't make it to the meeting.

Look for the MHQG volunteer intake team inside the large Center doors of Mountainview Church. Please enter the building through the center door on the front, next to the Fireside room, to the right of the main entry to the church starting at 6:00 pm. Remember that quilts do need sleeves on the in order to be hung properly.

Your quilt will have a printed ID card pinned to the back and then it will be placed in a plastic bag for protection. Quilts will be stored in a secure room within the church. Your quilt will always be in the plastic bag until hung for the show. Every care will be taken to protect your quilt. There will be white gloved volunteers to show off your quilts at the show on both Friday and Saturday.

After the show closes at 4:00 pm and the quilts are taken down, they will be sorted and made ready for pick up. Please be prepared to pick your quilt (or make arrangements for pick up) at 5:00PM on Saturday, October 15.
